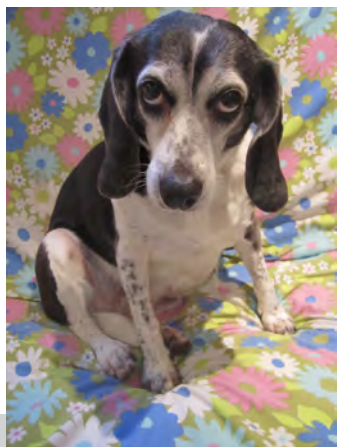
Opie

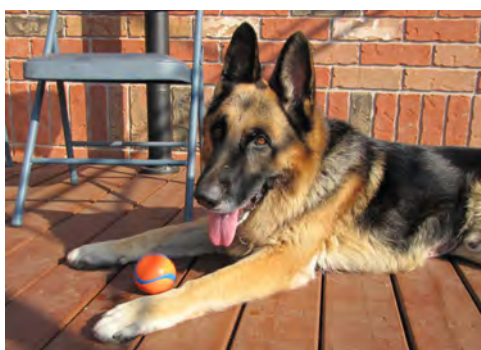
Star

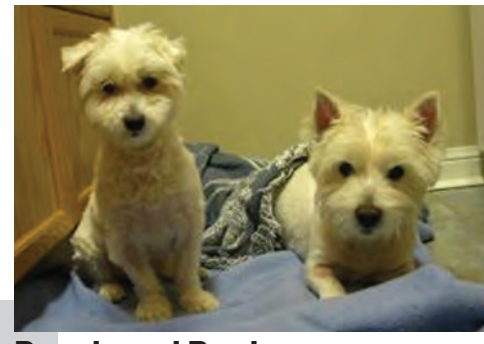
Riley

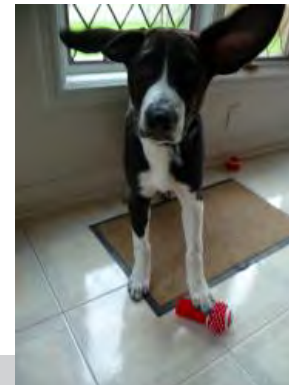
Luca

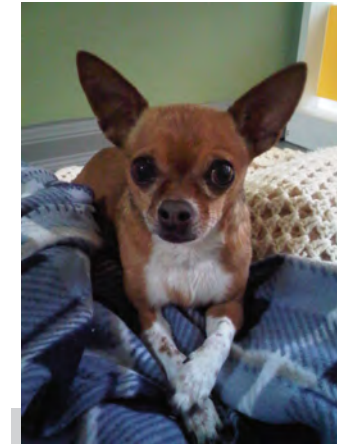
Reggie and Brady

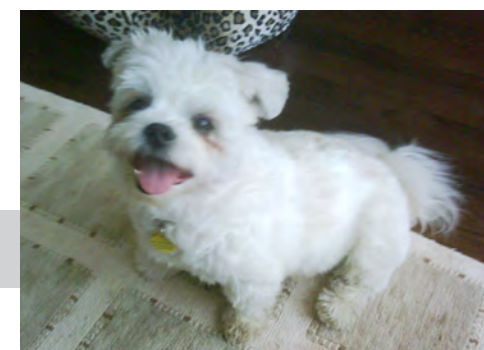
Chico

Ellen adores Izzy – another dog advertised on Kijiji that originally went to someone who realized they weren't able to properly care for a dog.



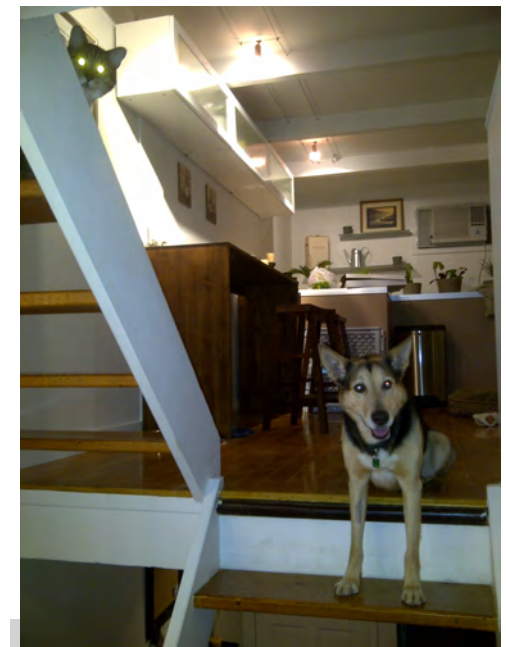
Star
